Read-A-Thon Fundraiser

Dear Friends and Family,

We are excited to introduce you to our family adoption **Read-A-Thon** Fundraiser! This is a fundraiser event for our adoption which will help raise funds while encouraging our children's love for reading. Our children, Ansel and Sophia, wanted to help bring their brother home. They have decided this was a way they could make a difference and are asking you to consider joining them. The **Read-A-Thon** allows our children to have an active role in helping bring their brother home by raising money without selling anything. One hundred percent of the money collected will go directly to our next payment in the adoption process. ANYONE can participate. We will be officially kicking off the **Read-A-Thon** on Thursday, April 13th, 2017 when you can begin collecting pledges. This is designed to be easy and fun, so we are hoping everyone will participate.

Here's how it works- Starting Thursday, April 13th participants will secure pledges from friends and family. First, participants will set a "minimum goal" for themselves. Each sponsor will pledge to pay for each minute the participant reads or are read to! The sponsor can choose any amount they wish, or choose to pay a flat fee for the total minutes read. Second, participants will begin reading. Minutes are counted, instead of books for this fundraiser. For two weeks (May 1st-May 13th) participants will read and record their minutes each day by using the Minute Recording Sheet.

When the reading period ends, the participant will tally up their minutes, collect their pledge money from sponsors, and will mail the collected money to us by Friday, May 26th. You may also drop off your final donations to us at an arranged time. Everyone who participates will be entered to win an Usborne book prize pack.

Again, ANYONE can participate. Parents can read to younger children and parents can collect pledges and read those books that have long waited to read. Our desire is to engage people in reading while raising funds for our adoption. This packet includes a Guidelines Page, a Sponsor Form, Minute Recording Sheet, and an Information Sheet about our family and our adoption for you or your children to share with people as you seek pledges.

We have been blessed us with an opportunity to receive the profits from an Usborne book party as well. This is a great chance to purchase new books to read for the Read-A-Thon, books as Easter gifts, or both. My Usborne party will be a Facebook show on April 2nd. Reading anything, in any language.

Reading assigned homework.

Reading aloud to others.

Being read to by other people

DOES COUNT

Reading before the official beginning of the Read-A-Thon does NOT count.

Reading during class time does NOT count

Please remember to be honest with your minutes so that it will be fair and fun for everyone! The last day for the Read-A-Thon is Saturday, May 13. No minutes will be counted after May 13.

Make sure that you return your collected money to us by Friday, May 26th, to be eligible for the Usborne book Prize Pack give away.


